

acid net



An acid cement remover for eliminating building residues. Removes cement and plaster residues of all kinds and efflorescence in general.

Composition:

Among other ingredients, acid net contains:

- < 5% non-ionic surfactants;</p>
- aromas

Phosphorous content:

Total Phosphorus by spectrophotometry UV-VIS 18800 mg/l

The testing method is based on the UNE-EN ISO 6878 standard

Instructions for use:

Dilute in clean water in a proportion of 1:1 to 1:5. The concentration will depend on how dirty the tiles are. In the case of stubborn dirt, it can be used undiluted. Apply evenly over the surface to be cleaned and leave to work for a few minutes. If necessary, scrub with a non-abrasive scouring pad and rinse afterwards with plenty of water. Repeat the operation until all the residues have been removed. Before using the product, a test should be made to find the correct concentration. Make sure that the tile grout has set properly before using the product. Coverage: approx. 90-100 g/m².

Warning
